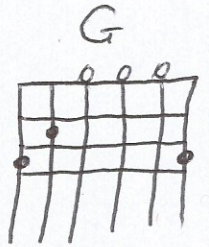


# Folsom Prison Blues

Johnny Cash



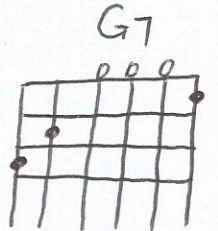
**G**

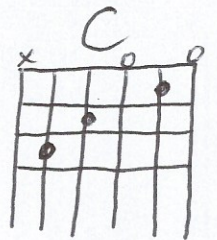
**G**

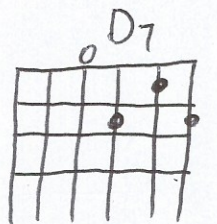
**G**
