[Cmaj7] Tired of lying in the sunshine [Gmaj7] staying home to watch the rain
And, [Cmaj7] you are young and life is long and [Gmaj7] there is time to kill
today

[Cmaj7] And then one day you find [Bm] ten years have got behind you

[Am] No one told you when to run, [D] you missed the starting gun

The [Am] time is gone, the song is over, [Am7] thought Id something [Eb]
more to say
