Intro: open G tuning with slide guitar

Verse 1:

[G] I woke up this mornin', feelin' round for my shoes

[G] You know 'bout that babe, had them old walkin' blues

[C] Woke up this mornin', feelin' round for my [G] shoes

[D] You know 'bout that babe, [C] yoo hoo,

I had them old walkin' [G] blues [D]

Verse 2:

I'm [G] leavin' this mornin', I have to go ride the blinds,

[G] I've feel mistreated, and, I don't mind dyin'

This [C] mornin, I have to go ride [G] a blind

[D] I been mistreated, [C] baby, and I don't mind [G] dyin' [D]

Verse 3:

[G] People tell me, walkin' blues ain't bad

[G] Worst old feelin' I, most ever had,

[C] People tell me these, walking blues ain't [G] bad

[D] Worst old feelin', [C] I most ever [G] had [D]
