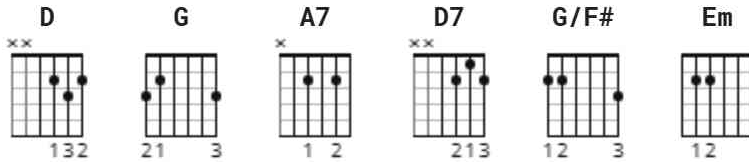


Wild Side Of Life Chords by Status Quo
